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## **Vermont's Population is Growing Older**

One in four Franklin County residents are over the age of 60 (25% or 12,340 adults), making it the second youngest population in the state. Since 2001, Franklin County has experienced a decreasing youth and an increasing older adult population. An increasing older adult population creates new challenges and emerging health risks.

### **Removing Barriers to Support Healthy Aging**

Age Strong VT is working to make sure all Vermonters can age well. There are health differences between age

decades in Franklin County which should be considered when planning institutional support for all older adults. The proportion of older adults living alone increases substantially from less than 30% for adults 60-79-years-old to 60% for adults 80 years and older. Older adults who live alone are at higher risk for loneliness, injury from falls, and cognitive decline. Adults 80 years and older have a higher prevalence of not receiving the social and emotional support they need compared to adults 60-69-years-old. About one-third of all older adults fell in the past year. Ten percent of 60-69-yearolds experience cognitive decline. Not seeing a healthcare provider and drinking alcohol at a risk level decreases with age.
